




Who do you think you are?

During this half term, we're going to find out what makes us the people we are. We'll consider what traits and features give us our identity, thinking about what makes us unique. We'll learn about how to create a classification system, then we'll gather data about physical features and genetic characteristics. We will also investigate fingerprints and create a 3D model of one, before designing clothing that reflects our personality.
