

How can I use this with my children?

As a fun party game to play indoors or in an outside space.

Hide the dragons in safe places for your child and their friends to go and hunt. See if they can find where the dragons have hatched and from which egg.

How does this help my children's learning?


A twist on a hide and seek type game where children are encouraged to problem solve and find where the dragons have hatched. Each dragon will match its egg design. This encourages pattern and colour identification.

Ideas for further learning:

You could try writing letters or numbers on the back of the dragons for the players to write on their answer sheets. Maybe choose letters which could spell out a word, or ask them to add the numbers up to reveal a total.



Dragon Egg Hunt Game




- How to Play:
- · Print off a Dragon Egg Hunt sheet for each player or team.
- Print off a set of dragons. (You might like to print them onto card or laminate them to make them a little more rigid.)
- Hide the dragons around your party venue. You could use a holepunch to make a hole in the dragon pictures and thread some ribbon through to help hide the dragons in different places.
- Explain to the children that each dragon has hatched from an egg
 the pattern and colour of each dragon matches an egg on the egg
 hunt list. The dragons are hiding around the venue. As the children find a dragon, they need to tick the matching egg on the sheet.
- Remember to let the players know where the playing area is and which areas are out of bounds.
