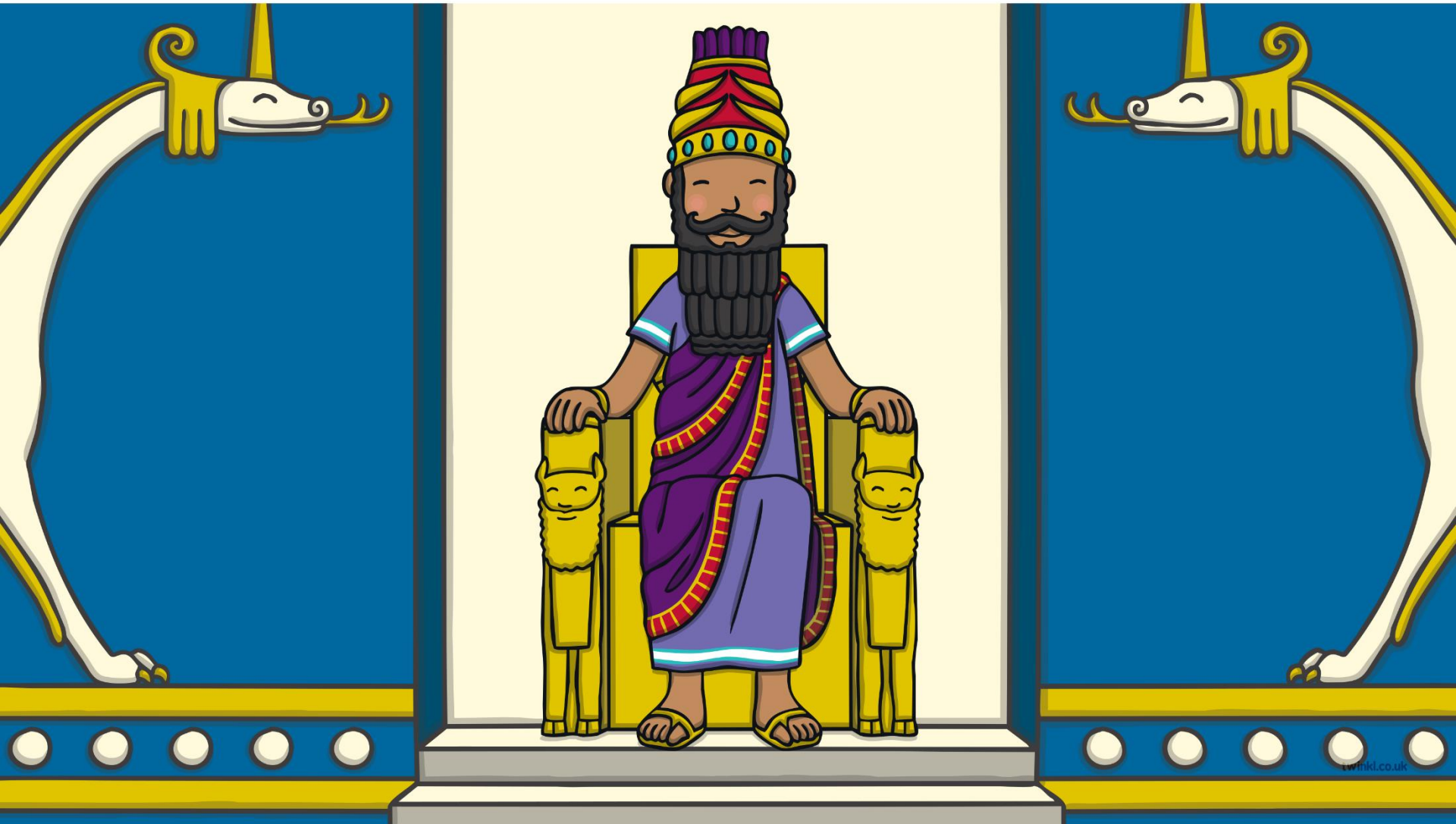
King Darius

The king was so impressed with Daniel that he decided to put him in charge of the whole kingdom.



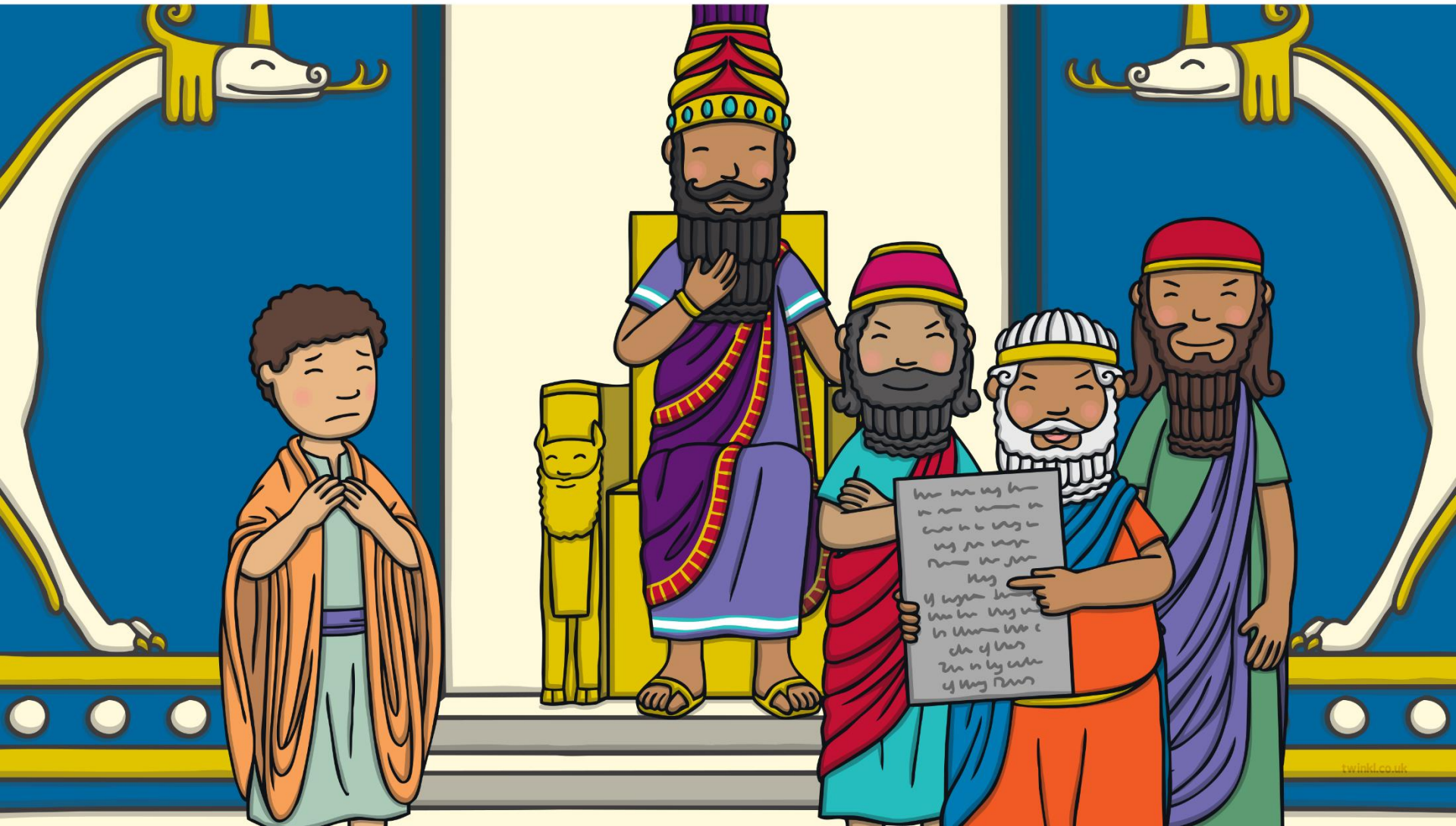
The governors were jealous of Daniel and tried to find fault with him, but they found nothing wrong.



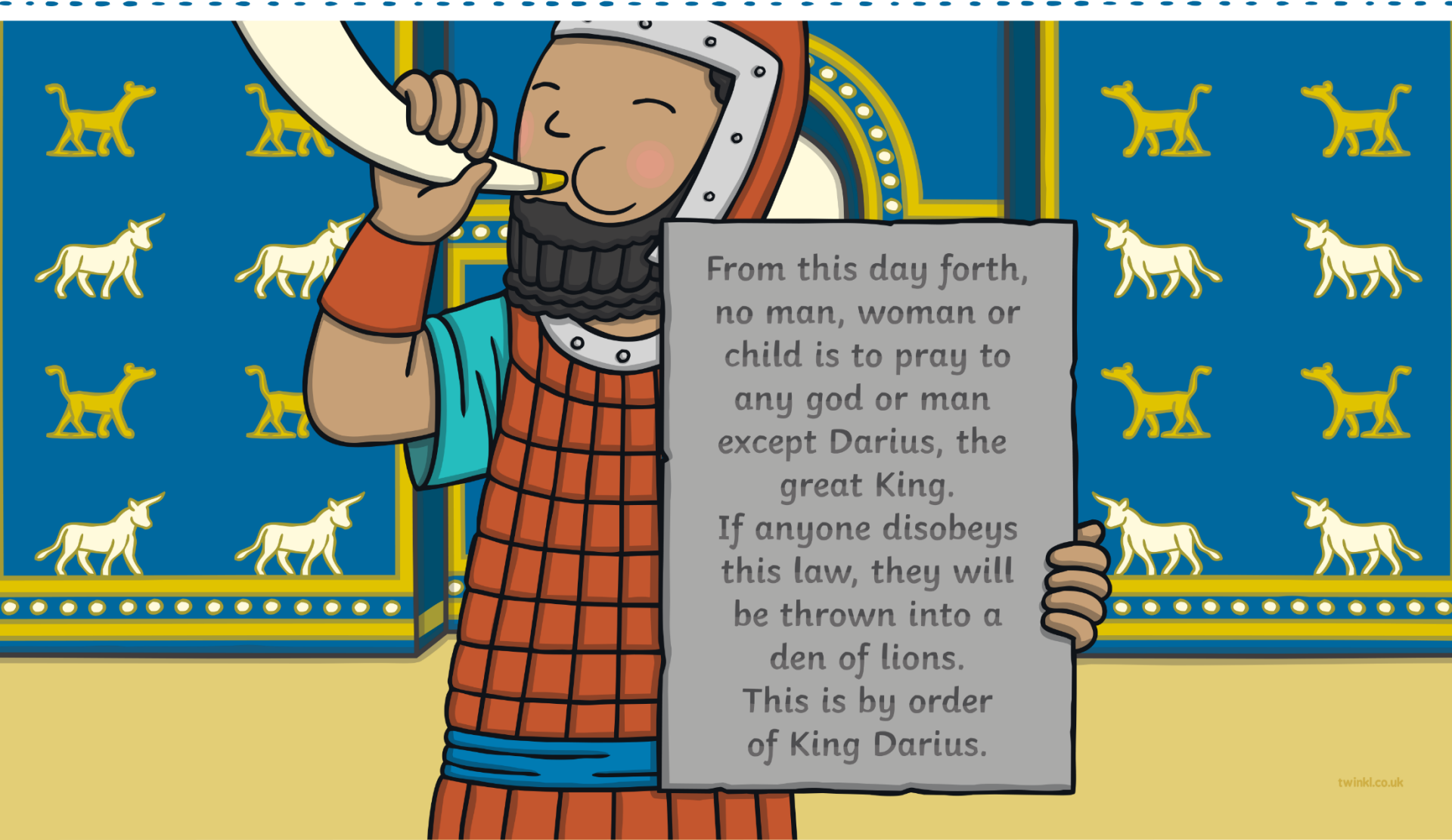
So the governors came up with a devious plan.
