Amazing Artists in Year 6!

In Year 6 the children have been completing an art unit during their 'Identity topic'. They have studied artist, Frida Kahlo, and then created their own self-portraits in the same style.

They learnt all about Frida Kahlo's life and looked at examples of her work. She was a surrealist artist, meaning that there were certain things about her portraits that she exaggerated. She is famous for painting herself with larger eyebrows and also adding facial hair. The children practised techniques

for drawing facial features before copying a photograph of Frida Kahlo. They then used a photograph of themselves to help create their own self-portrait in which they exaggerated one feature. The final touch was to create a collage of their favourite things for the background using digital art. They were amazing!
