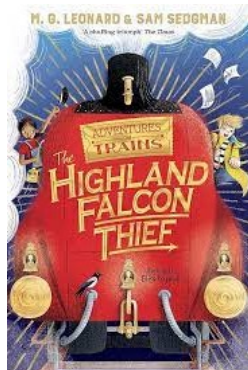
WWII. Our big idea is: What was life like for children during WWII?
