Dear Parents & Carers,

Thank you to all of you who took the time at parents' evenings to complete the Parent & Carer Survey. The Governors value your feedback immensely, as it helps us both recognise what is great about Keyworth Primary & Nursery School, and what can be improved.

In total, we received 98 responses so a big thank you!

Please find a summary of the survey results below, along with some comments and response from the school leadership team.

| The school lets me know how my child is doing. | 45% | 50% | 2% | 0% | 2% |
| I know how to support my child's learning at home. | 50% | 47% | 1% | 0% | 2% |
| General communication between school and my family is helpful and efficient. | 44% | 49% | 2% | 1% | 3% |
| There is a good range of subjects available to my child at this school. | 43% | 52% | 0% | 0% | 5% |
| My child can take part in clubs and activities at this school. | 47% | 45% | 2% | 0% | 6% |
| The school supports my child's wider personal development. | 35% | 59% | 0% | 0% | 6% |

Overall, **94%** of respondents would recommend KPNS to another parent.



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Some of the positive comments from the survey:

Areas for Improvement

1) Special Educational Needs & Disabilities (S.E.N.D.) provision

Compared to last year's survey, the perception of the school's support for children with S.E.N.D. has decreased.

There were no Parent & Carer comments related to this area.

Response from school leadership team:

All schools have found responding to SEND issues hugely challenging in recent years due to a reduction in funding and external support for SEND issues. Some schools are describing the current situation as an unprecedented crisis. KPNS has certainly experienced difficulties in accessing the support and funding we need for SEND and have been proactive in writing to our MP and other figures with influence to voice our concerns.

It should be noted that in 2024, only 3 families felt that their child with SEND did not receive the support they needed; however, this was an increase from 2023 when only 1 family responded negatively.

In 2024, the other 7 families who responded to this question about SEND either agreed, or strongly agreed, that their child with SEND is being well supported.

We continue to aim for all parents of children with SEND to feel their child is well supported – this is an ongoing focus of great importance for staff and governors.
