The bake sale raised nearly £100 which will go towards buying new books for some of our topics in school. The Librarians from each class will help Mrs King make a good selection.


Comic Relief

Year 5 had a wonderful afternoon with Ben in the WonderDome mobile planetarium.

They watched a film which was all about the joint Space Agencies (NASA and the European Space Agency) project to put men (and women) back on the moon. They then watched footage of the Artemis spacecraft which is currently under construction at the huge NASA building at Cape Kennedy, Florida. Next they watched simulations of the launch and subsequent landing on the moon. Finally they took a trip through a nebula, and watched the birth of a protostar and its development into a supergiant then its explosion. It was a super cool experience.


