We have also been notified that there will be a increased presence of enforcement officers checking parking around school.

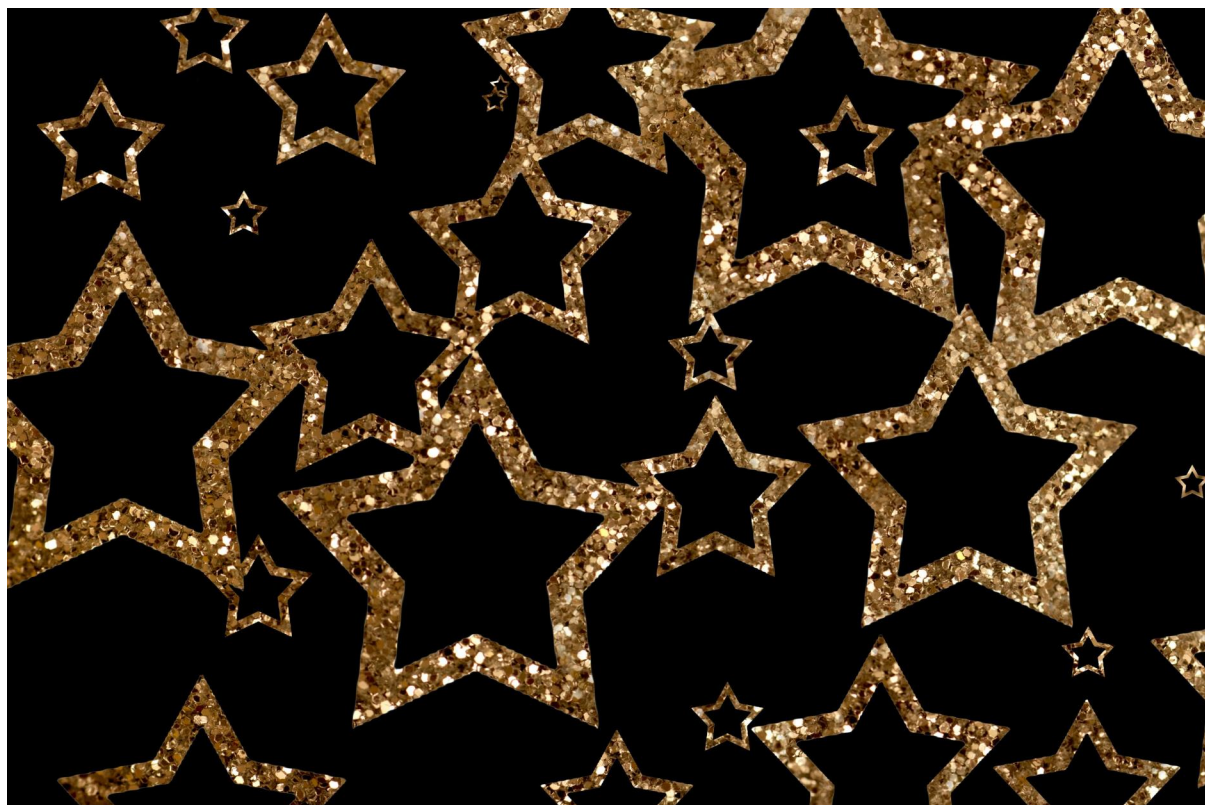
Year 6 SATs Week

Very soon our Year 6 pupils will take part in the end of Key Stage 2 Statutory Assessment Tests (SATs). These will be completed during the week commencing Monday 12th May as follows:

- Monday 12th May - English grammar, punctuation and spelling (grammar paper and spelling paper)
- Tuesday 13th May - English reading (1 paper)
- Wednesday 14th May - Mathematics (arithmetic paper and reasoning paper)
- Thursday 15th May - Mathematics (reasoning paper)

The tests will be completed during the school day and will take place in the mornings. We would like to invite all our Year 6 children to come in for a special SATs breakfast that week at 8:30am in the big meeting room. KPNS Musical Showcase!



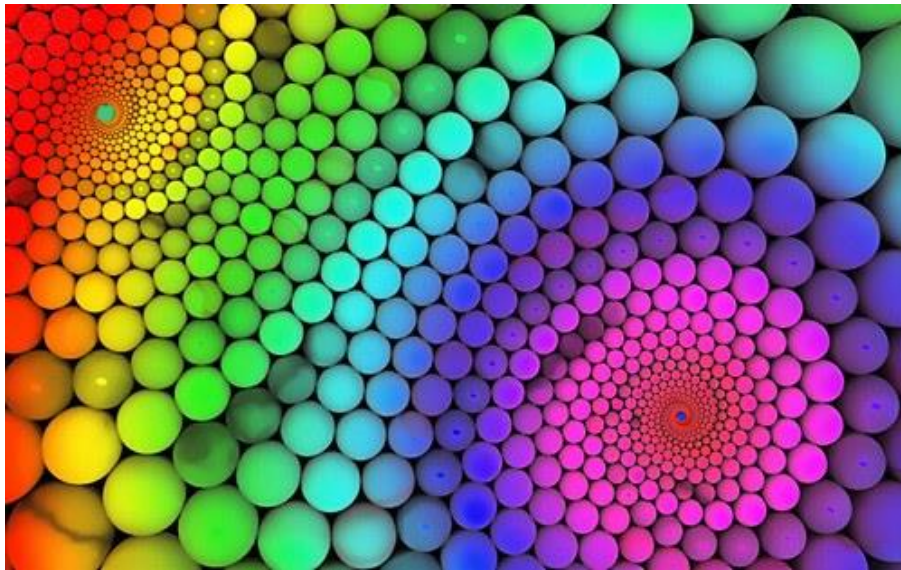
