Why do earthquakes happen, and volcanoes erupt?

Science: We will be learning about rocks and soils.

Year 3 are discovering the wonders of rocks, fossils, and soils. Learning how different rocks are formed, how fossils tell us about the past, and what makes soil so important for life.

Maths:

We will be covering Addition/Subtraction and starting our multiplication and division unit.

RE: Light & Dark (exploring Christianity and Hinduism).

We will be exploring key themes in Christianity and Hinduism, including how light is used as a symbol in religious stories, celebrations, and belief.

PE/ Swimming: Swimming is on a Thursday afternoon. In PE, you will be working with Mrs Wales and doing gymnastics.

ICT: We will be exploring how computer simulations help us learn and problem-solve, while also developing essential skills in staying safe online.

Music: We will be practising music through the Sing Up module, focusing on the unit 'I've Been to Harlem', where children will develop their musical skills through singing, rhythm, and performance.

Geography: Our big idea is: Why do earthquakes happen, and volcanoes erupt?

We'll learn what happens when the Earth shakes, what causes volcanic eruptions, the fascinating Ring of Fire, and real-life case studies of famous earthquakes and volcanoes.
