Literacy

We will be focusing on:

- Journalistic writing about a "Rocketeer" Rescue
- Short Burst writing to develop the toolkit skills for Journalistic writing
- VIPERs texts linked to writing and our history topic including extracts from *Treason*, *Boy in the Tower*, *Isaac Newton* and Poetry

History

- What happened to Henry's wives?
