School uniform

- Remember to label clothing
 - Appropriate clothing for the time of year e.g. winter coat during colder weather; hat and suncream during warmer weather
 - No jewellery to be worn apart from a pair of stud earrings which must be removed for PE
- Grey skirt or pinafore dress
 - Black or grey trousers or shorts
 - White blouse or shirt
 - Red and white checked dress
 - Red sweatshirt, cardigan or fleece
 - Flat, plain, black shoes that do not feature branding (not trainers)

PE clothing

- Remember to label clothing
- Separate pair of shoes for PE
- Long hair must be tied back for PE lessons

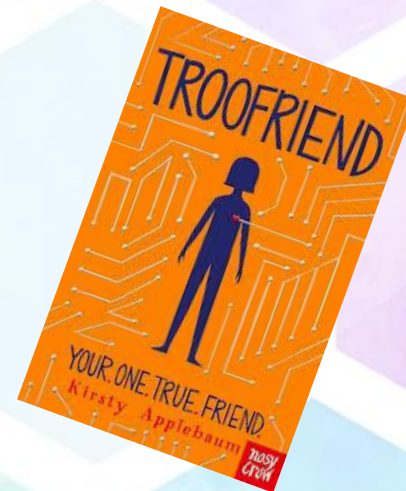
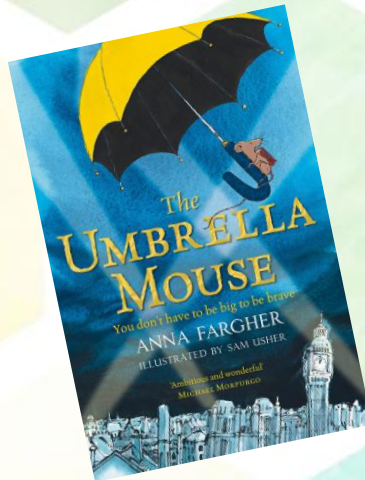
- Black/ navy shorts
- Red T shirt
- Plimsolls or trainers
- Tracksuit/ warm top for cold weather

School equipment

- Children can bring their own water bottle which should be kept in the designated space in the classroom (usually by the sink)
- Children should not bring their own stationery
- Children should not bring fidgets (if they have had a sensory assessment that says they need a fidget, this will be provided by school)

Homework expectations

- Stay in the green zone on Doodle maths and spell
- Read at least 3 x per week and record in the home/school book
- Home/school books should be brought into school every day
- Complete the reading awards every term (Bronze for autumn, Silver for spring and Gold for summer) – these are all in the home/school books
